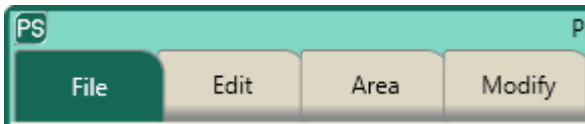


Cropping the Start and End Point on a Sashing or Border Repeat.

Learn how to crop the start lead in and end lead out of a repeated design.

1. Select Design

- Select **File** tab.



- Press **Design**.



- Press **Open**.
- Select **Designs/HQ Designs/Continuous Line/Leaf Trail**

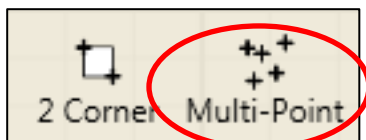


2. Create an Area

- Select **Area** tab.



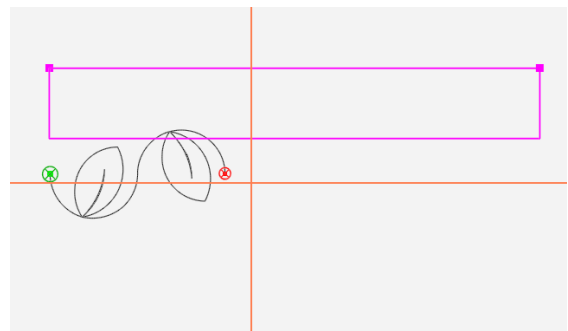
- Move machine to a corner of the border on the quilt.
- Press **Multi-Point**.



- Continue moving the machine and pressing **Multi-Point** around to the other three corners of the border.
There should be four points for the area.

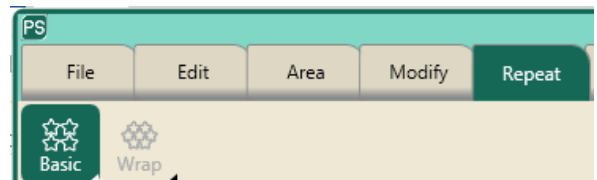


- The area now appears as a pink rectangle border.
- Press **Refresh** in the status bar at the bottom of the screen. The sashing area, design and crosshairs will be visible in the workspace window.

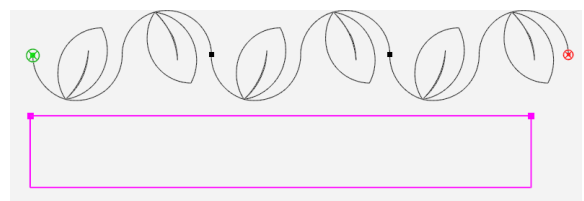


2. Repeat Design

- Press **Basic**.



- Repeat the amount that looks best in area.
Three repeats works best for this area.



- Press **Baseline** in the Quick Access toolbar or find **Baseline** under the Modify tab. This action will cause the three repeats to become one long repeat.

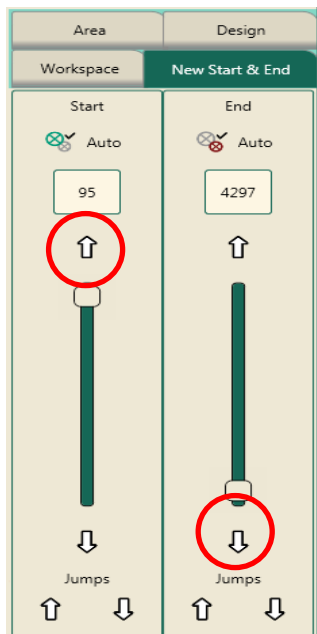


4. Move Start and End Points

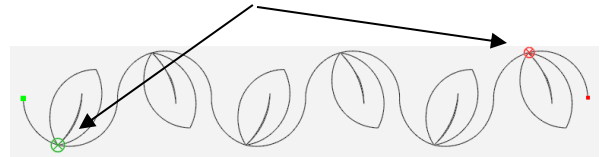
- Select **Pro-Stitcher** tab at the top of the screen.



- Press **New Start & End** in the Ribbon.
- Move the green **Start** circle to the base of the leaf at the beginning of the leaf repeat and then move the red **End** circle to the base of the leaf at the end of the leaf repeat by pressing the arrows.

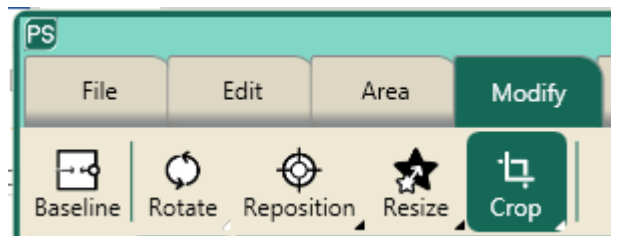


- Notice where the green Start and the red end circles have moved to.



5. Crop

- Select **Modify**.
- Press **Crop**.



- Press **Start End** in the sidebar.



- The beginning tail and the end tail will be cropped off.



- Compare the two repeated designs to see the difference.

Start and End Not Cropped



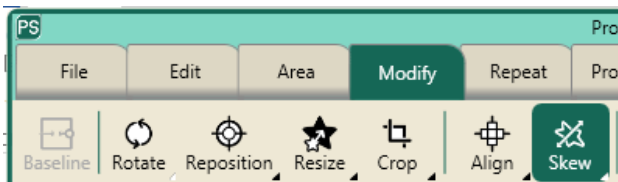
Start and End Cropped



6. Skew to Area

Select **Modify**.

Press **Skew**.



- Press Skew 1.



- The design will skew into the area box without tails on either end.
